

VVA Meeting of 5/4//2016

Meeting was called at to order at 7 pm by VP Larry Wrycza who led us in the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by Dan Zeigler with an opening prayer.

The April 2016 Secretary report was accepted as mailed out.

Treasurer Report was then given by Joe Heil: The Chapter checkbook balance is \$10,024.25; expenses were renewal of our raffle license (\$50), EC Parks & Recreation (\$60) for our Welcome Home Picnic event, Farmer Insurance (\$675) for the event insurance policy for our four days in Carson Park; credits were a rebate due to the number of members of \$720, dues of \$140. The Welcome Home Picnic account balance is \$12,444 and we could still use another \$4-5,000. Joe asked that in the future there needs to be frequent audits with him and the Board of Directors. In the past our bank balance has not had a balance that would warrant audits, now however, it is felt that audits take place, at least quarterly. It should also be noted that all monies received and expenses for the Welcome Home Picnic are kept separate from the Chapter Motion was passed to accept the Treasurer Report. A separate motion was made and passed to have the Chapter donate \$1,000 to the Welcome Home Picnic fund. Joe also mentioned that on June 10th there will be a golf outing at Lake Hallie with the proceeds going to Horse Ride for Veterans.

Dennis Werlein then got up to say good bye as Chapter President and appealed everyone to sign-up to volunteer for the various opportunities to serve during our Welcome Home Picnic this June at Carson Park. Dennis then expressed his best wishes and good luck to the new President and God Blessings on our Chapter.

Chapter Elections: Mike Korger was nominated and approved as the new Chapter President; Roger Schuh was nominated and approved as Secretary. Now that elections are done, Joe Heil can file our 1090 and financial report.

President Mike Korger took the floor and he appointed Joe Graff as Sergeant at Arms. He then made some corrections to the previous Secretary Report, and there were two corrections to the March Treasurer Report, motion passed to accept the finalized reports.

National Report: Region 6 meeting will be in St. Cloud, MN this year from June 2-5, 2016; those interested in attending please contact Joe Heil so reservations can be made, cost is \$25 for early registration and \$35 for late registration.

State Council Report: Joe Heil states that State will meet at Highground in Neillsville on June 18th at 10 am.

VA Report: Pete Breed encouraged those who are filing claims to be sure you have the supporting documents for any claim filed and if that claim is denied, APPEAL that original claim **DO NOT FILE A NEW CLAIM.** It may be something as simple as supplying additional information for the initial claim to be processed and filing another claim will only delay, confuse and make a mess so be sure you **APPEAL!** He then spoke about the gun raffle of Henry Rifles and a letter he is processing to Henry Rifles to see if they will donate the riles we are interested in raffling, a .22, 30/30 and a .44 Mag Big Boy, with the proceeds to benefit the VFW Unmet Needs Program and Chapter 5 with the net proceeds being split 50/50. Chapter 5 has already donated a cash prize of \$200 and National is also donating a cash prize of \$200, Budweiser Banners have also been donated.

Minority Report: Roger Schuh did not have a Minority Report

Membership Report: As of 4/30/16 we have 126 members and with new applications that have been sent in we will have a membership of around 130/132.

Old Business: Veterans Home Report-there is \$32,000 in the state budget for a new home which is felt should be used to expand the Veterans Home at Chippewa Falls rather than elsewhere in the state.

Highground Report: On Saturday, May $14^{\rm th}$ at 9 am in Cadott there will be a Hmong ceremony, Dennis Werlein will be speaking and our Chapter will provide the Color Guard. Afterwards we will leave and go to Highground for a Legacy Stone laying of 22 stones. At the Learning Center is on the Hmong culture. The Gulf War Tribute will be July 12-25 with the Dedication on July $23^{\rm rd}$. We will new Color Guards for Highground events in July.

Clothing Report: Shirts, boonie hats, etc. usually take a week to arrive once ordered. If you want to place an order, please contact Joe Heil.

Fundraising Report: Larry Wrycza reports that our 4^{th} Annual Chicken feed will be at the American Legion Post 53 on Water Street this year on Saturday, September 10^{th} . Paul has agreed to cook the chicken and will be bringing the grills. Right now our focus is on the Welcome Home Picnic and after June, our September fundraising will kick into gear.

Good of the Order: Vets Council meeting was attended by Joe Heil last week. Rod Anderson is working with Tim Moore about the van and to get more volunteer drivers signed us. So far there are only five drivers qualified to drive, if anyone wishes to volunteer, please refer to Tim as all CVSOB need to pre-screen driver applicants. You can go to the DAV website and follow the Wolunteer link. \$6,000 has been donated for a van purchase and \$15,000 has been received from a donor in Illinois. The van is purchased, the DAV marks it and then the van belongs to the VA Minneapolis. This van will not cover going to Tomah, will need to raise more money for this. The DAV covers the expense of insurance on the van. The DAV will go 50/50 with our Chapter for the Christmas Party at the Veterans Home at Chippewa Falls.

Color Guard volunteers are needed for May 29th at St. Matthew and May 30th for the Eau Claire Memorial Day Parade, line up at 8:30 am at Wilson Park.

Dennis Werlein added that the Education Committee will be at Memorial High School tomorrow for a presentation. Dan Zeigler commented that the presentation at Regis was very emotional.

Thoughts were discussed of moving our monthly meetings to American Legion Post 53 on Water Street starting the first of the year. A motion was passed to change signatures on the Chapter checking account from Dennis Werlein to Mike Korger. Winners in tonight drawings were Ken Lestrud and Ed Laventure, both were not present; there were 28 members in attendance, the meeting adjourned at 8:30 pm
