Mac served 22 years, before retiring a Captain in 1982. Mac served 5 Tours in Vietnam between 1965 and 1971. He was the recipient of the Distinguished Service Cross, Purple Heart and the Silver Star. He will be laid to rest at Arlington National Cemetery.
